Why Do We Do That?

Well, I'm glad you asked! Sometimes, the shortest month of the year feels like the longest. We begin February with Candlemass (which has morphed into a day where we celebrate a rodent looking for the sun) and this year ends with an extra day to help balance our Julian Calendar with the astrological calendar. That's a long way of saying February begins with Groundhog's Day and ends with a Leap Year day.

In the middle of the month, we begin our Lenten season by spreading burnt blessed palm leaves on our foreheads. Ash Wednesday comes relatively early this year because the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox is early this year. That is, Easter Sunday is on March 31 and Lent begins 40 days beforehand (plus 6 Sundays or Feast Days of Our Lord, where we are called to feast not fast). Clear as mud, right!?

Lent is a traditional time of preparation and solemnity. During Lent beginning on February 21 at 5:15 pm we will gather for a Soup Supper, and I will lead a discussion on Transitions. We will continue to meet on Wednesday evenings through Lent to discuss change. I hope to see you. And if you would like to make a batch of soup, please sign up on the bulletin board, that would be very helpful.

And finally, I will be leading a preparation group on Sunday morning between services starting at 9:00 am. Beginning February 11 until April 21 when we host our new Bishop, the Rt. Rev. Anne B. Jolly! If you would like to be Confirmed, Received, or Reaffirm your Baptismal Covenant, or if you simply want to know why we do the things we do in the Episcopal Church, please come, and see!

I am very much enjoying my time with you as your Interim Rector, and you all continue in my daily devotions.
