GRACE EPISCOPAL 2025 LITTLE FEET MINISTR

It's that time of year again where we hold our Little Feet shopping event for our young friends at our community schools. As in past years we will be serving Grant, Edison, Thomas Jefferson, Longfellow Elementary and Royal View schools. JCPenney in Mentor will supply the shoes/boots. We will follow the same format as in past years:

- The Family Liaisons at the schools identify families with the greatest need.
- Eligible families will receive vouchers from the schools. These vouchers will be given to the cashier at JCP at the time of purchase and matched with a master list of children who are eligible for the program.
- Grace Episcopal purchases a JCPenney gift card which is held by JCPenney and used to purchase the shoes.
- On the shopping date, the children (with their parent or guardian) shop and select their own shoes. This is a real self-esteem boost for the child and so much fun!

As always, we need your assistance in meeting and greeting, and assisting these families at the store on shopping days. If you would please join us for an hour or two - or more if you can, we would greatly appreciate your help. Or, you can just stop in and say "Hi"!


Please know how much we treasure your partnership. Every bottle filled, every dollar given, and every prayer lifted up matters—and together it's making an eternal difference.
